SCHOLARSHIP

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The Don Owens Memorial Lodge #88 annually awards scholarships to graduating seniors who are the children of Active Members of FOP 88. Scholarships awarded total \$500.00 for each graduating senior and may be used at any approved and accredited College, University, or technical school.

Payment is made directly to the qualifying College, University, or technical school of choice. Scholastic ability, scholastic achievement, and a 500 word essay are among the criteria used to select recipients. Determination will be made by members of the FOP 88 Scholarship Committee. Applicants will not be interviewed. Awards will be announced by April 30, 2014.

Other necessary qualifications include:

1. Minimum Grade Point Average of a B (3.0).
2. Submission of high school transcript.
3. Scholarship must be used the fall semester following award.
4. Member must have had an ACTIVE status the 5 years preceding the award.

CHECKLIST FOR A COMPLETE APPLICATION

1. A completed application form.
2. Official transcript of high school credits, grades, and list of completed subjects.
3. A minimum of three letters of recommendation. Letters should include at least one recommendation from each:
 - a. Teacher, counselor, or administrator.
 - b. Employer or extracurricular activity counselor.
 - c. Personal – someone in a position to know the applicant well.

Items 1 - 3 should be arranged in the given order and then stapled together. Return the completed application to an FOP 88 Executive Board member no later than **March 21, 2014.**
